Circulation-All Materials

Adult-7,226

Children-1,569

Total Circulation=8,795

Collections-All Materials

Due to a smaller space in 2015, most of the collection was in storage and about a quarter of it was housed in that place, in that year.

Loans-All Materials

Received from other libraries-2,429

Gave to other libraries- 2,025

Library Programs

Adult-30 programs (attendance- 263)

Children-63 programs (attendance- 1,003)

One on One Sessions-104

Internet Use-1,128 people accessed it (not including WI-FI usage)

Let's talk in dollars using the above...

If we offered programs at 6.00 a ticket (price of a movie) = 1,370 attending X \$6.00 a ticket= \$8,220.00

If we offered each circ at an average of \$20.00 an item (cost of a DVD, book) =8,795 total circ X \$20.00 an item = \$175,900.00

If we offered Internet Access at \$12.00 a person = 1,128 X \$12.00 a person = \$13,536.00

Comes to a total of \$197,656.00

The cost to you = \$0

The cost of a library card= \$0 (priceless)
